The Walk-In-Centre is open from 07.00-22.00 Monday-Friday and 09.00-22.00 at Weekends and Bank Holidays.

The X-Ray department is open from 08.00-22.00 for walk-in-centre patients and 09.00-22.00 Weekends and Bank Holidays.

Every patient who attends the Haywood Walk in centre is triaged and assessed by a qualified nurse. The triage will determine the priority of order in which patients are seen.

Patients can self-refer to the Haywood, you do not need to be referred by your GP.
